As a Waterski Boat Driver you will work with club members and the Waterski Coach when available. The majority of your time will be spent in a ski boat, while the remainder of your time may be spent assisting dock staff and/or supervising staff. Opportunities will exist in the planning and execution of tournaments; such as providing familiarization sets prior to tournaments and management of the dock at the time of the tournaments. We are looking for experience, professionalism and enthusiasm for all members of our team.

The Waterski Boat Driver will report to the Club President +/- Waterski Coach. The club president will not be on site the majority of the time. This will require that the candidate have maturity +/- experience in such a role.

Located in the lovely and self contained town of Carp, Ontario. Loch Cameron Waterski Training Center offers a world class ski lake and surveyed ski course. The lake has recently changed hands, having been previously managed by the Ottawa Ski Club. We will try to build on the previous work of the Ottawa Ski Club to bring a competition and training environment to waterskiing in the Ottawa Area.
