

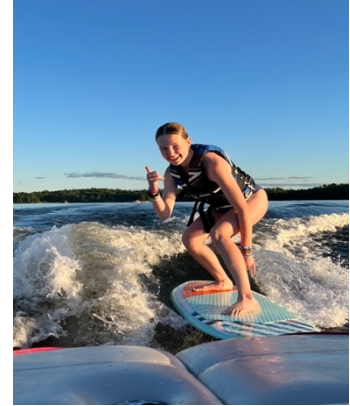
## **Exciting Summer Job Opportunity at HOC**

- Current certificate of Emergency First Aid & CPR (Standard First Aid preferred).
- Respect in Sport certification.
- Pleasure Craft Operator's License & experience driving ski boats.
- Knowledge & experience in water ski and wake sport disciplines.
- Possess the ability to teach and communicate with varied ages of campers.
- Possess strong group control skills.
- Must be an enthusiastic, energetic, and positive person.
- Must be willing to take part in camp related activities outside the defined job description.
