3-B/ Memberships for Organizations:

Club: \$200.00:

What is defined as a club: A club is a non-profit organization focused on towed watersports where everyone involved (members, volunteers, staff, and participants) must be a member of WSWO. Clubs provide community, training, recreational activities, events, and may also host competitions under the WSWO/WSWC umbrella. ALL members are covered under WSWC's general liability insurance.

School: \$200.00:

What is defined as a school: A school is typically a for-profit or instructional operation where clients can take lessons or programs without becoming members of their provincial association. However, active schools are expected to use trained instructors, and all staff and coaches must hold current NCCP certifications and WSWO memberships. Only the coaches, instructors and staff are covered under WSWC's insurance.

Camp: \$200.00:

Camp memberships require one trained instructor on staff in the first year of membership, and in continuing years there must be one trained instructor per boat PLUS all waterfront staff need to be WSWO members, regardless of their certification level.
